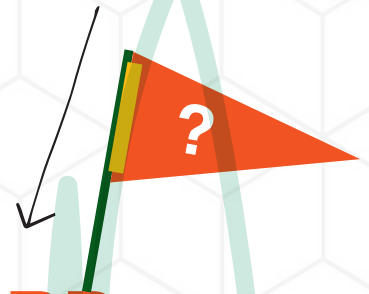

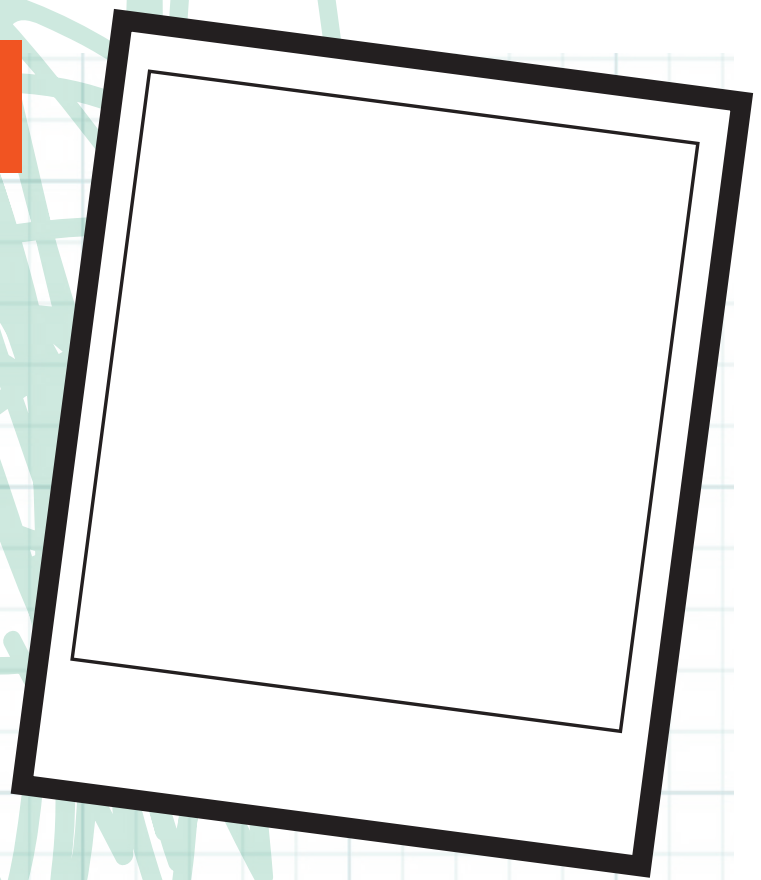


WHAT IS ARTS AWARD BRONZE NORTH EAST EDITION?

Part C

Arts Inspiration
