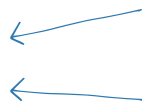


Part B: Explore

Explore an Artist

An artist could be an actor, musician, dancer, designer, animator, photographer, filmmaker, games designer, writer or anyone who makes and creates artistic work. We have lots of very talented artists in the North East.



Explore an Arts Organisation

Did you know that there are LOTS of different arts organisations? An arts organisation could include a museum, a library, a theatre company, a music organisation, a dance company. They could be local to you, national or international. There are lots of different types and sizes of arts organisations.

We're very lucky to have brilliant arts organisations in the North East. For example, did you know that the ONLY dedicated children's theatre outside London is in Darlington at Theatre Hullabaloo? 

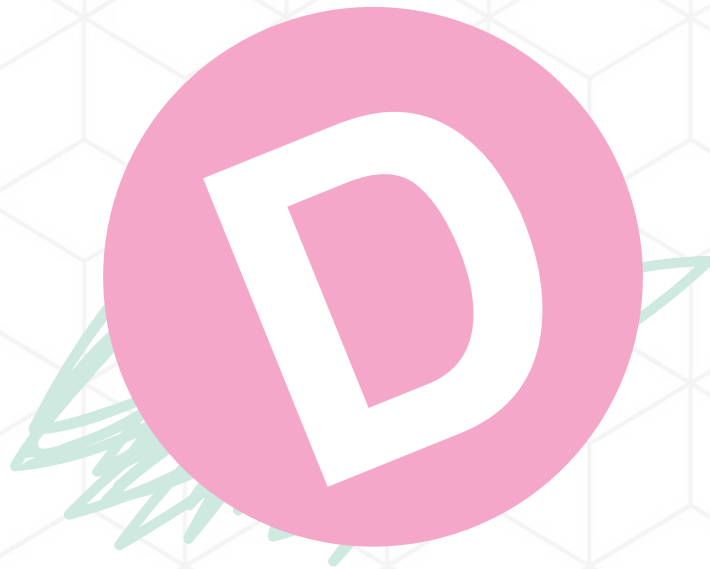
