Each talk will be 30min long and will focus on a key issue in schools/educational settings.

We are looking to focus our 4 week programme on the general themes below:

Sessions should be structured 20 min talk with 10 mins for discussion/questions.

We are looking for educators to submit proposals for these talks. Your proposal should be for a 30 min session and focus on one of the above themes. We want to help the cultural sector to understand the key issues, demands and needs that schools and settings are facing so that effective partnerships between the cultural sector can be forged and flourish.

1. Who you are and how we can get in touch with you.
2. The theme/title of your proposed talk and what our audience will learn from it.
3. An outline of the content.
4. How you will actively engage our audience.
5. Costs.
